Basic Information

The Air District is located in the Norm Covell Clean Air Building in downtown Sacramento at the corner of H and 12th Streets. The office is served by a variety of transit services, including <u>Yolobus, Regional Transit</u> (RT), and the <u>Capital Corridor</u>. The Sacramento International Airport is less than 20 minutes away by car or bus.

From the Airport

The Air District is 20 minutes from the Sacramento International Airport via car or <u>Yolobus Route 42A</u>. Service is hourly; disembark at J and 8th Streets and walk 4 blocks northeast to H and 12th. Route 42B will bring you back to the airport; pick up is on L and 10th. Super Shuttle, taxis, and car rentals are other options.

By Train

The Sacramento Amtrak train station is located at 401 I Street, seven blocks from the Air District, and a tenminute walk directly east and one block north. Amtrak's Capitol Corridor trains operate between the Bay Area and Sacramento, and Amtrak California's San Joaquin trains and motor coaches connect the lower Central Valley to Sacramento. Other Amtrak trains include the Coast Starlight and the California Zephyr.

By Light Rail

RT's 'Blue Line' light rail service stops just across the street from the Air District. RT also operates many bus lines and additional light rail trains that travel throughout the area.

By Car

Parking is limited. The Norm Covell Clean Air Building has no public parking. There is on-street metered parking adjacent to the building on H street, and several paid parking lots in the area, one at F and 12th and a city garage at H and 15th Streets. The meters & garages accept credit cards.

Driving directions to Sacramento:

- From the Bay Area, take I-80 East, then I-80 Business (Capital City Freeway), then I-5 North.
- From Central/Southern California, take I-5 North, or take US-99 to I-5 North.
- From the east, take US-50 West to I-5 North, or I-80 West to I-5 South.
- From the airport and other points north, take I-5 South.

Once in Sacramento: Take the J Street Exit east to 11th Street and turn left. Go two blocks and turn right on H St. Our brick building is on the northeast corner of H and 12th.

Hotels

The Best Western Sutter House is directly across the street. Other nearby hotels include the Sterling Hotel, the all-ages Sacramento Hostel, the Hyatt and the Sheraton.
