- c. COMPLETION DATE: Any revision made to a completion date must be delivered, facsimiled, or postmarked to the Air Pollution Control Officer, on or prior to the date being changed in the plan. When a demolition or planned renovation involving the disturbance of RACM will be completed on a date different from that specified in the most recent plan, the owner or operator of a demolition or renovation shall notify the Air Pollution Control Officer of the new completion date by written notice via the U.S. Postal Service, a commercial delivery service, hand delivery, or by electronic media.
 - 1. If the completion date is being delayed, the notification must be delivered to the Air Pollution Control Officer on or prior to the date being changed; and
 - If the revised completion date is earlier than the date being changed, the notification must be delivered to the Air Pollution Control Officer no later than one working day prior to the actual project completion date.
 - 3. The Air Pollution Control Officer may approve, in writing, a notification period shorter than one working day prior to the actual project completion date.
