The committee members may earn a monthly stipend, depending upon their eligibility and whether funds are available.

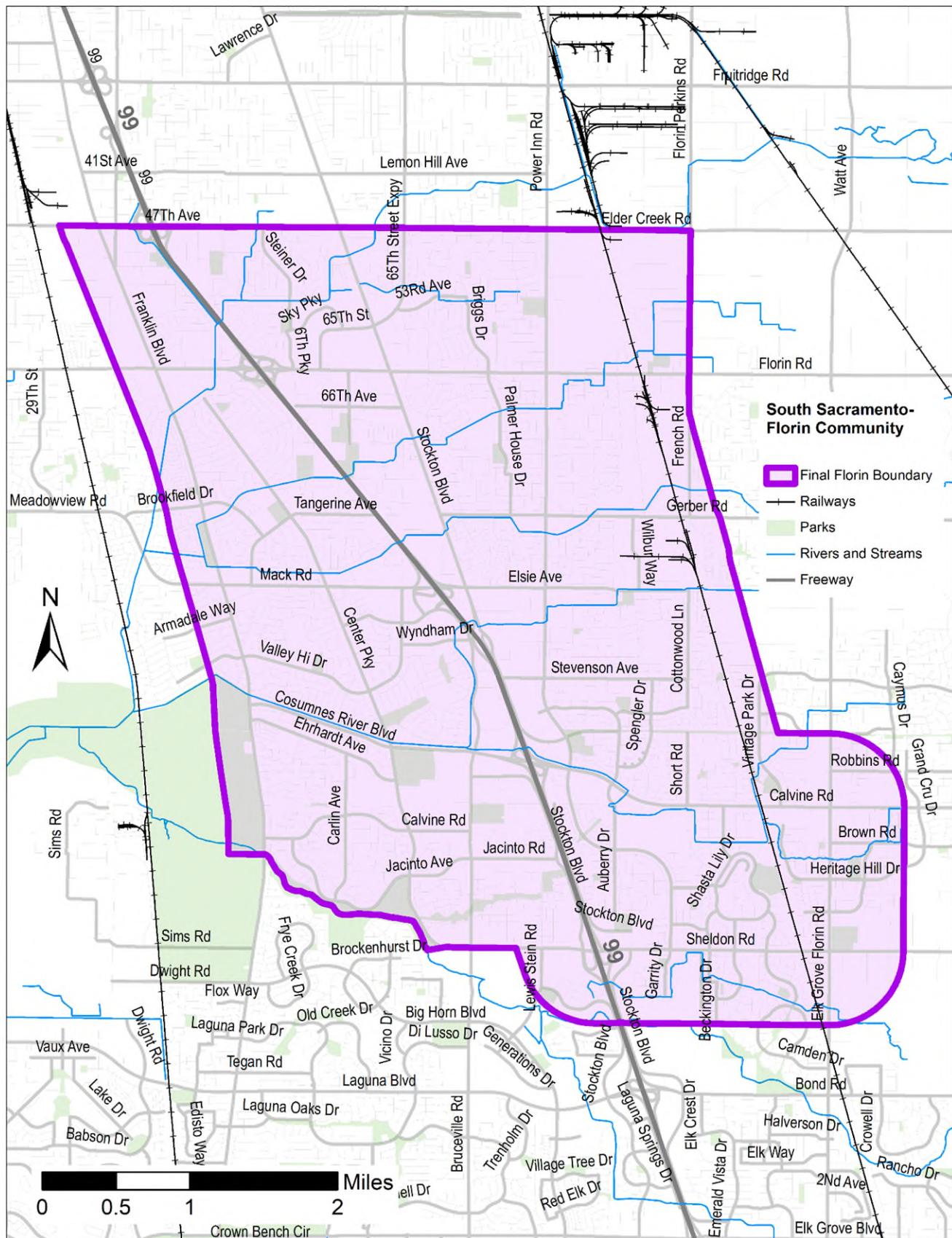
