The main agenda topics for this meeting were:

- CAMP questions from Steering Committee Members

Meeting Takeaways:

- The Steering Committee was updated on how the District and Steering Committee efforts were being impacted by shelter-in-place orders and the COVID-19 outbreak
- The District presented the draft Community Air Monitoring Plan and walked through the Executive Summary and the 14 elements of the plan. The Steering Committee will vote on the draft CAMP at the regularly scheduled May meeting.
- The District has shared the Draft Community Air Monitoring Plan with several outside experts for their review including: South Coast Air District, Dr. Wexler of UC Davis Air Quality Research Center, Sonoma Technology Inc., and CARB. Comments received from these experts will be on the District website (<http://www.airquality.org/Air-Quality-Health/Community-Air-Protection/Steering-Committee>).
- Steering Committee members and members of the public provided comments on the draft CAMP and asked clarifying questions.
- Under new business, the Steering Committee discussed the formation of a Technical Advisory Group (TAG) and the experts they would like to have on the TAG. There will be further discussion at a future meeting.

Action Items:

- The District will send out a poll for Steering Committee members to prioritize New Business topics to discuss at future meetings.
