The Sacramento Metropolitan Air Quality Management District reached a settlement with the following permitted source(s) between April 1 and June 30:

Permitted Source: AMPAC Fine Chemicals  
Address of Violation: Highway 50 and Aerojet Road, Rancho Cordova  
Penalty Amount: \$12,360  
Violation: Rule 201 (General Permit Requirements)

Permitted Source: Oscar Lopez (Allied Construction)  
Address of Violation: 7218 Franklin Boulevard  
Penalty Amount: \$24,594  
Violation: Rule 901 (Asbestos)

These penalties were reached through the District's Mutual Settlement Program, a voluntary program designed to resolve violations without the time and expense of litigation. Settlement funds will be used to help support the District's mission of improving air quality in the Sacramento region.
