The <u>Recommended Guidance for Land Use Emission Reductions, Version 5.0</u>, creates a common platform of information and tools so developers, communities, and lead agencies can disclose air emissions and select appropriate design features, conditions of approval, and mitigation to reduce those emissions.

Version 5.0 includes the following revisions:

- Updates to the discussion about CalEEMod 2022 and discussed changes to baseline data used to calculate vehicle miles traveled.
- Updated references to the 2021 CAPCOA Handbook and updated guidance for creating a baseline/unmitigated business-as-usual project scenario that will be used to set an emissions reduction target compared to mitigated project emissions.
- Updated links to climate action plans and greenhouse gas reduction strategies.
- Directs users to the CAPCOA Handbook and CalEEMod and removes an outdated list of mitigation measures.
