## IMPORTANT INFORMATION REGARDING POINT OF SALE IMPROVEMENTS

If you own or operate a gasoline dispensing facility and are making changes to your card reading system to comply with security measures, you may need to submit an application to modify your current Air Quality Permit.

If you are replacing at least half of your dispensers, you must apply for a new permit. To apply for a new permit, you need to fill out forms G100 and GDF100 and submit them to the Air District. You can find these forms on our website at <a href="https://www.airquality.org">www.airquality.org</a>.

Please keep in mind that *it may take up to six months to receive your permit once you submit your application*. Apply as soon as possible if you plan to replace dispensers as part of a card reading upgrade.

Replacing your dispensers before you are issued a new permit is a violation and results in fines.
