**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING PURCHASE OF SPONSORSHIP FOR  
SACRAMENTO BUSINESS ENVIRONMENTAL RESOURCE CENTER  
POLLUTION PREVENTION AWARDS EVENT SEPTEMBER 20, 2004**

**WHEREAS**, the Sacramento Federal Nonattainment Area (SFNA) has been designated a “Serious Nonattainment Area” for the federal ozone standard with an attainment deadline of 2013; and

**WHEREAS**, the Sacramento Metropolitan Air Quality Management District (District) is a founding member of the Sacramento Business Environmental Resource Center (BERC); and

**WHEREAS**, BERC provides a valuable service to both the District and the regulated community by helping businesses understand and comply with air quality regulations that achieve emission reductions, thereby improving air quality; and

**WHEREAS**, BERC annually produces a Pollution Prevention Awards event that highlights the successes of businesses implementing practices that improve air quality in our region, thus setting an example for other businesses that encourages the use of such practices; and; and

**WHEREAS**, the Pollution Prevention Award also offers the SMAQMD an opportunity to provide air quality education and outreach to attending businesses and regional leaders through an on-site exhibit booth and Business Journal display advertising; and

**WHEREAS**, sponsorship of the BERC Pollution Prevention Awards event will demonstrate District commitment to pollution prevention through the use of the District’s logo on event materials, signage and advertising; and

**WHEREAS**, the Pollution Prevention Awards event directly assists the District in its mission to improve air quality

**THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Board of Directors approves a sponsorship of the 2004 BERC Pollution Prevention Awards in the amount of \$2,250.
