

AQMD RESOLUTION NO. _____

SACRAMENTO METROPOLITAN AIR QUALITY MANAGEMENT DISTRICT

WHEREAS, Health and Safety Code Section 40961 states that the Sacramento Metropolitan Air Quality Management District is the local agency with the primary responsibility for the development, implementation, monitoring, and enforcement of air pollution control strategies, clean fuels programs and motor vehicle use reduction measures within Sacramento County; and

WHEREAS, the Sacramento Metropolitan Air Quality Management District is authorized by Health and Safety Code Section 41062 and Section 41082 to implement programs to reduce transportation emissions, including programs to encourage the use of alternative fuels and low-emission vehicles; and

WHEREAS, on October 23, 2003 the Sacramento Metropolitan Air Quality Management District Board of Directors approved AQMD Resolution Number 2003-048 to distribute these funds; and

WHEREAS, \$15,000 remains unencumbered from the \$54,600 allocation toward the purchase of two additional clean fuel school buses; and

WHEREAS, the Elk Grove Unified School District compressed natural gas refueling station has been out-of-service for 56 work days since October 2003; and

WHEREAS, the Elk Grove Unified School District is in need of repairs to their station; and,

WHEREAS, the intent of this Resolution is to approve a recommended allocation of funds from school buses to infrastructure repair.

Therefore, Be it Resolved and Ordered by the Board of Directors of the Sacramento Metropolitan Air Quality Management District, that the revised distribution of funds be and hereby is approved.

Be it further Resolved and Ordered by the Board of Directors of the Sacramento Metropolitan Air Quality Management District, that the Air Pollution Control Officer is hereby directed to do everything within his authority to carry out the provisions and intent of this Resolution.
