WHEREAS, Health and Safety Code Section 41014 authorizes the District to conduct and support programs or projects with respect to transportation emission control measures; and

WHEREAS, the use of bicycles as a mode of transportation is an accepted alternative mode, the use of which reduces emissions that would occur through use of an automobile; and

WHEREAS, it is a goal of the District to enhance the infrastructure needed to encourage citizens to use bicycles instead of the automobile; and

WHEREAS, the 50 Corridor Transportation Management Association intends to use funds received by the SMAQMD to help fund a two-year effort to develop a plan for transforming the Folsom South Canal into a transportation and recreation corridor; and

Now, therefore, be it Resolved and Ordered by the SMAQMD Board of Directors that the Air Pollution Control Officer is authorized and directed to sign a Memorandum of Understanding with the Folsom South Canal Partners, in a form similar to the attached, on behalf of the Sacramento Metropolitan Air Quality Management District and to do and perform everything necessary to carry out the purpose of the resolution.
