WHEREAS, Health and Safety Code Sections 40961 designates the Sacramento Metropolitan Air Quality Management District as the local agency responsible for influencing public and private agencies whose actions may have a positive or adverse impact on air quality within the Sacramento District; and

WHEREAS, Health and Safety Code Sections 40716(a) and 41013 authorizes the District to adopt and implement regulations to reduce or mitigate emissions from indirect and area-wide sources of air pollution; and

WHEREAS, the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) requires that public agencies consider and disclose the environmental effects of decisions by public and governmental decision-makers, and mandates that agencies implement feasible measures or alternatives that would mitigate significant adverse effects on the environment; and

WHEREAS, in 2000, the SMAQMD supported the INDEX modeling and public outreach effort to determine feasible smart growth options and potential air quality benefits in the area surrounding Swanston Light Rail Station; and

WHEREAS, the SMAQMD welcomes opportunities to partner with community leaders to examine opportunities to build smart growth projects which support the SACOG Blueprint Project and identify new projects which will improve air quality.

NOW, THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that the Board of Directors of the Sacramento Metropolitan Air Quality Management District hereby endorses the **SMAQMD** financial contribution of \$2000.00 to support the feasibility study for Swanston Arden/Expo streetcar service in the Point West area of Sacramento.
