Transportation Authority (STA) and the Sacramento Metropolitan Air  
Quality Management District (SMAQMD) to Financially Support the  
Sacramento Transportation and Air Quality Collaborative (Collaborative)  
for FY 05-06

## Recommendations

Staff recommends that the Board:

1. Approve the attached Resolution, which authorizes the Air Pollution Control Officer to sign the attached MOU on behalf of the SMAQMD.
2. Direct the Clerk of the Board to forward the fully executed MOU to the Sacramento Transportation Authority.

## Background

Formed in 2000, the Collaborative is a multi-year effort involving all major segments of the community in a comprehensive countywide planning process. This process is looking at the issue of how to accommodate the huge population increase expected in the area over the next 20 years, while maintaining or improving the area's quality of life, particularly in terms of transportation and air quality impacts. It is a countywide process within a regional context. SACOG is participating.

The Collaborative effort is scheduled to finish on December 31, 2005. The Collaborative staff is working with the stakeholders to complete work products by that date, including:

- Air Quality
- Infill
- Transportation
- Urban Form
- Open Space & Location/Phasing of Development
- Civic Engagement

## **Funding**

On March 24, 2005 the SMAQMD Board of Directors approved the FY 05-06 Measure A Expenditure Plan. Included in that Plan was a \$100,000 allocation for the Collaborative. Of this \$100,000, the SMAQMD's contribution is expected to be \$30,740 for the period July 1 – December 31, 2005. The attached MOU memorializes the SMAQMD's financial support of the Collaborative's efforts for FY 05-06.
