WHEREAS on January 27, 2005, the Board approved the Supplemental Paid Military Leave Policy; and

WHEREAS the Supplemental Paid Military Leave Policy requires SMAQMD to pay qualifying military personnel the difference, if any, between their military pay and their SMAQMD pay, for up to one year; and

WHEREAS the Board directed that this policy be submitted for renewal annually; and

WHEREAS the current Supplemental Paid Military Leave policy expired on June 21, 2006;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Supplemental Paid Military Leave Policy is renewed for the period of June 22, 2006 through June 20, 2007.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Air Pollution Control Officer, in consultation with the District Counsel, is authorized to approve subsequent minor changes to the policy or changes necessary to conform with amendments to state or federal law.
