Whereas, GVC is a non-advocacy, non-partisan organization focusing on growth issues of a nineteen county area stretching from Redding to Bakersfield.

Whereas, GVC intends to develop and distribute the Great Valley Center's 2005 report entitled The State of the Great Central Valley of California: The Environment.

Whereas, the 2005 Great Valley Center Report provides unbiased public information on the state of a number of environmental indicators including: air quality, water quality, land use, species and habitats and resources.

Whereas, the information provided in the Great Valley Center Report furthers the public education mission of the SMAQMD

Now, therefore, be it resolved that the Air Pollution Control Officer, in consultation with the District Counsel, is authorized and directed to negotiate and sign a funding agreement with Great Valley Centers, in a form similar to the attached, on behalf of the Sacramento Metropolitan Air Quality Management District and to do and perform everything necessary to carry out the purpose of the resolution and agreement.
