Subject: RESOLUTION TO SPONSOR AB 2804 (SALINAS) AND WAIVE STATE REIMBURSEMENT FOR ANY COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH AB 2804

RECOMMENDATIONS

Adopt the attached resolution to sponsor AB 2804 (Salinas) and waive any and all state reimbursement for any costs associated with AB 2804.

BACKGROUND

At your last meeting (April 27, 2006), your Board authorized staff to introduce and promote legislation to add this section to the Health and Safety Code:

40982. Each member of the Sacramento district board shall receive actual and necessary expenses incurred in the performance of board duties, and may receive compensation, to be determined by the Sacramento district board, not to exceed one hundred dollars (\$100) for each day attending the meetings of the Sacramento district board and committee meetings thereof, or, upon authorization of the Sacramento district board, while on official business of the Sacramento district, but the compensation shall not exceed six thousand dollars (\$6,000) in any one year. Compensation pursuant to this section shall be fixed by ordinance.

Assemblymember Simon Salinas has agreed to author legislation (AB 2804 as amended on May 4, 2006) that will add the above section to the Health and Safety Code. The bill is also being co-authored by Assemblymembers Dave Jones and Roger Niello. The author believes that, if AB 2804 is to be favorably decided, your Board needs to adopt the attached resolution calling for the District's sponsorship of the legislation and waive any and all state reimbursement for any costs associated with AB 2804.
