

SACRAMENTO METROPOLITAN AIR QUALITY MANAGEMENT DISTRICT

Resolution No. _____

WHEREAS, Health and Safety Code Section 40900 states that there shall be a basinwide air pollution control council in each air basin which is comprised of all or part of two or more districts; and

WHEREAS, Health and Safety Code Section 39606 required the State Air Resources Board to divide California into air basins considering similar meteorological and geographic conditions; and

WHEREAS, Section 60106 of Title 17 of the California Code of Regulations defines the Sacramento Valley Basin as including Tehama County, Glenn County, Butte County, Colusa County, Yolo County, Sutter County, Yuba County, Sacramento County, Shasta County, an eastern portion of Solano County, a western portion of Placer County; and

WHEREAS, Health and Safety Code Section 40900 requires that the council consist of an elected official of, and designated by, the district board of each district which is included, in whole or in part, within the air basin; and

WHEREAS, Health and Safety Code Section 41865, the Connelly-Areias-Chandler Rice Straw Burning Reduction Act of 1991, restricts rice burning in the Sacramento Valley Basin and requires the Sacramento Valley Basinwide Air Pollution Control Council to annually determine the maximum percentage of planted rice that may be burned in the basin subject to conditions in the statute; and

WHEREAS, Section 80155 of Title 17 of the California Code of Regulations required the Sacramento Valley Basinwide Air Pollution Control Council to submit a smoke management program to the State Air Resources Board for the Sacramento Valley Air Basin; and

WHEREAS, the Sacramento Valley Basinwide Air Pollution Control Council may make periodic updates to this program pursuant to Title 17 of the California Code of Regulations; and

WHEREAS, Section 80156 of Title 17 of the California Code of Regulations, Conditional Rice Straw Burning Permit Program for the Sacramento Valley Air Basin, required the Sacramento Valley Basinwide Air Pollution Control Council to submit a rice straw burning permit program to the State Air Resources Board; and

WHEREAS, the Sacramento Valley Basinwide Air Pollution Control Council may make periodic updates to this program pursuant to Title 17 of the California Code of Regulations; and

WHEREAS, the incumbent council member representing the Sacramento Metropolitan Air Quality Management District, Ill Collin, will retire at the end of the year 2006; and

WHEREAS, the Director Don Nottoli has expressed willingness to assume the role of District representative to the Sacramento Basinwide Air Pollution Control Council

Therefore, be it resolved and ordered by the SMAQMD Board of Directors that Director Nottoli shall assume the role of District representative to the Sacramento Basinwide Air Pollution Control Council effective January 1, 2007, and that the Air Pollution Control Officer will convey this resolution to the other members of that Council.
