Recommendation

The Board may wish to endorse, oppose or remain neutral on seven November 2006 ballot measures of interest to the district.

Purpose

The APCO has identified six such ballot measures that may impact the district's ability to achieve its mission and a seventh of compelling interest to the greater Sacramento region. In summary, the APCO recommends the following positions: SUPPORT on Propositions 1C, 1D, 1E, and 87; NEUTRAL on Propositions 1A and 1B, and; OPPOSE on Proposition 90
