**Subject:** Request by Dome Printing & Lithograph, Aerojet and the State of California  
General Services for Emission Reduction Credits from the Community Bank

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**Recommendation**

1. Approve the attached resolution transferring a total of 3,704 pounds per year (lb/year) of NOx to the State of California, General Services Department - Central Heating and Cooling Plant from the Community Bank.
  2. Approve the attached resolutions transferring a total of 2,784 pounds per year (lb/year) of Reactive Organic Compounds (ROC) to Dome Printing & Lithograph from the Community Bank.
  3. Approve the attached resolutions transferring a total of 728 pounds per year (lb/year) of ROC, 328 lb/year of nitrogen oxides (NOx) and 81.6 lb/year of particulate matter (PM10) to Aerojet from the Community Bank.
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**Executive Summary**

Rule 205, Community Bank and Priority Reserve Bank, requires that requests for emission reduction credits (ERCs) from the Community Bank be approved by the Board when the term of the loan is greater than 5 years or the loan amount is greater than 900 pounds per quarter. Staff has received six loan requests that meet these criteria.

The State of California, General Services Department made a request for 3,704 lb/year of NOx emission credits for a 5-year term from the Community Bank to use for alternative compliance from Rule 411, NOx from Boilers, Process Heaters, and Steam Generator.

Dome Printing & Lithograph made requests for loans totaling 2,784 lb/year of ROC to renew two existing loans to offset emissions from lithographic printing presses. The existing loans were for 8 years and the request extends the loans for an additional 5 years for a total life of 13 years.

Aerojet made requests for loans totaling 728 lb/year of ROC, 328 lb/year of NOx and 81.6 lb/year of PM10 emission credits for 20-years from the Community Bank to offset emissions from a new 3.45 MMBTU/hr boiler, a solvent cleaning operation on an Atlas V rocket motor case and a modification made to a chemical manufacturing process.

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**Background**

State of California, General Services Department - Central Heating and Cooling Plant: The State of California, General Services Department is applying for an Authority to Construct/Permit to Operate number 20241 to use the alternative compliance option under Rule 107, Section 102, Alternative Compliance in lieu of retrofitting a boiler to comply with the new NOx limit in Rule 411. Recent amendments to Rule 411 require facilities to meet lower NOx emission limits. Rule 107 provides for the use of an alternative compliance option for facilities that cannot comply with the new NOx limit.

The State of California, General Services Department operates two natural gas-fired boilers. One boiler already complies with the 9 ppm NOx emissions limit. The applicant has requested to lease NOx emissions for 5 years based on the estimated remaining life of the non-compliant boiler. The applicant expects the non-compliant boiler to be replaced in about 2 years and requested that the emission credit loan be 5 years to account for any unexpected delays.

This loan request includes a 1.1 to 1 air quality benefit as required by Rule 107, Section 301.

Dome Printing & Lithograph: Dome Printing is applying to renew an Authority to Construct/Permit to Operate to extend loans originally obtained in 1999 for two lithographic presses. Dome Printing exceeds the offset trigger for ROC under Rule 202, New Source Review. The ROC emissions of 696 lb/qtr from the presses are currently being offset by existing ERC loans (Loan Number C99-3-014 and C99-3-015). The applicant has requested to extend the life of the current loan for 5 years. These existing loans are due to expire on October 6, 2007.

These loan requests include a 1 to 1 offset ratio as required by Rule 202, Section 303.1.b.

Aerojet: Aerojet is applying for an Authority to Construct/Permit to Operate to install a boiler, and start a solvent cleaning operation. In addition, Aerojet is requesting a loan for a chemical manufacturing process that had its emission offset requirement deferred. All these requests are to provide offsetting emission reduction credits of Rule 202, Section 301.1b. Aerojet does not currently own a ROC, NOx or PM10 credit certificate.

Aerojet is applying for an Authority to Construct/Permit to Operate to install a 3.45 MMBTU/hr boiler equipped with a low-NOx burner to comply with Rule 411. Aerojet has requested a loan totaling 12 lb/qtr (48 lb/year) of ROC credits, 82 lb/qtr (328 lb/year) of NOx credits and 20.4

lb/qtr (81.6 lb/year) of PM10 credits from the Community Bank for a twenty-year term to provide offsets for Authority to Construct 20384.

This loan request includes a 1 to 1 offset ratio for ROC and NOx and a 1.2 to 1 offset ratio for PM10 as required by Rule 202, Section 303.1.b.

Aerojet is also applying for an Authority to Construct/Permit to Operate for a new solvent cleaning operation. The cleanup process is performed on Atlas V rocket motor cases. Aerojet has requested a loan of 132 lb/qtr (528 lb/year) of ROC credits from the Community Bank for a twenty-year term to provide offsets for Authority to Construct 20419.

This loan request includes a 1 to 1 offset ratio as required by Rule 202, Section 303.1.b.

Aerojet is also applying for a loan for an Authority to Construct/Permit to Operate number 20030 which is a modification of Authority to Construct/Permit to Operate number 18793 issued in 2005. The Permit to Operate 18793 required 6 lb/qtr (24 lb/year) of ROC offsets. The Permit to Operate 20030 required 32 lb/qtr (128 lb/year) of ROC offsets. The District's Stationary Source Division deferred the ROC offsets and determined ROC offsets would not be required until a cumulative amount of ROC offsets exceeded 0.5 lb/day of ROC. With the addition of the offsets required for the boiler replacement, the offsets exceed 0.5 lb/day of ROC. Aerojet has requested a loan of 38 lb/qtr (152 lb/year) of ROC credits from the Community Bank for a twenty-year term to provide offsets for Permit to Operate 20030 and Permit to Operate 18793. The amount requested for Permit to Operate 18793 will be issued effective October 1, 2005. The amount requested for Permit to Operate 20030 will be issued effective January 1, 2007.

### Community Bank Approval Process

Rule 205, Section 310 states that the District Board of Directors must approve loan applications to the Community Bank prior to disbursement. These requests are for the September 27, 2007 Board hearing so that the emission credits are effective on October 1, 2007 except for loan C07-1015 that has an effective date of October 1, 2005.

In approving a loan request, the Board must consider the extent to which cleaner innovative technologies have been used to minimize credit needs and may conditionally grant loans to protect the health of the bank or to promote cleaner, innovative technology. The Board may deny any application if the Board determines that the denial is in the best interest of the Sacramento Federal Ozone Nonattainment Area.

### Use of Clean Technology

Rule 205, Section 310.5 allows the Board the authority to place conditions on loan approvals in order to protect the health of the bank or promote clean technology.

State of California, General Services Department - Central Heating and Cooling Plant: The boiler is currently complying with 30 ppm of NOx emission limit previously required in Rule 411 by utilizing alternative compliance option. The boiler will need to be replaced to meet the recently adopted 9 ppm of NOx limit as required in Rule 411. They are again requesting alternative compliance since the State plans to replace the boiler in about 2-5 years. They need the time to get the purchase in the budget.

Staff recommends that no additional conditions be placed on this loan. There is lower NOx technology that the State will be implementing once they have the money in the budget.

Dome Printing & Lithograph: Both lithographic presses have existing conditions for Best Available Control Technology (BACT). The inks, coating, adhesives, metering rollers and printing plate cleaner are required to meet Rule 450 emission limits. The BACT requirements that include low VOC fountain solution, automatic blanket and roller wash with solvent capture and recycle, low VOC cleanup solvent and kerosene-like based inks have limits that are less than Rule 450 and will continue to be enforceable permit conditions. In addition, the larger of the lithographic presses is vented to a catalytic incinerator to further control the emissions. Staff recommends that no additional conditions be placed on these loans.

Aerojet: This boiler is equipped with a low-NOx burner to reduce NOx emissions to 30 ppm. The NOx emissions will meet the Rule 411, NOx from Boilers, Process Heaters and Steam Generators emission limitations for this size of boiler that will become effective in October 2007.

The solvent cleaning operation utilizes evaporative loss minimization methods (i.e. controlled flow solvent dispensers & all solvents and materials contaminated with the solvent must be kept in closed containers when not in use). The cleaning operation requires higher VOC solvents to ensure proper bonding of materials onto the space vehicle to minimize a possible explosion during launch. Alternative solvents continue to be tested however only the higher VOC solvents have been approved by Environmental Health and Safety for this cleaning operation.

The chemical manufacturing process is vented to a non-contact heat exchanger with activated carbon.

Staff recommends that no additional conditions be placed on the Aerojet loans.

### Loan Applications Under Consideration

There are no other requests for ROC, NOx or PM10 emission reduction loans for this quarter other than the aforementioned requests.

### Health of the Bank

The current ROC, NOx, and PM10 balances in the three accounts are:

The approvals of the Dome Printing loan requests do not affect the account balances because the requests are renewals of current loans. These requests all come from the Community Bank. If the loan requests are approved as requested the ROC balance will be 549,190.6 pounds per year (274.6 tons per year), the NOx balance will be 21,198.9 pounds per year (10.6 tons per year) and the PM10 balance will be 940.3 pounds per year (0.47 tons per year).

### Priority Determination

Rule 205, Section 311, Community Bank Loan Prioritization, states that if loan requests exceed the quarterly funding cap, all loan applications in the funding cycle shall be prioritized. The total amount of credits requested from the Community Bank for all the requests are 3,512 lb/year of ROC, 4,032 lb/year of NOx and 81.6 lb/year of PM10 which does not exceed the funding cap.

## Loan Fees

The loan fees are as noted below. Annual administrative fees are also charged for each loan.

1. State of California - \$9,852.64.
  2. Dome Printing & Lithograph - \$3,814.08.
  3. Aerojet - \$11,203.13.
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## Conclusion

Staff recommends that the Board approve the attached resolution transferring the following from the Community Bank:

1. 3,704 pounds per year (lb/year) of NO<sub>x</sub> to the State of California, General Services Department - Central Heating and Cooling Plant.
  2. 2,784 pounds per year (lb/year) of Reactive Organic Compounds (ROC) to Dome Printing & Lithograph.
  3. 728 pounds per year (lb/year) of ROC, 328 lb/year of nitrogen oxides (NO<sub>x</sub>) and 81.6 lb/year of particulate matter (PM<sub>10</sub>) to Aerojet.
