WHEREAS, The Land Use and Mobile Source Division of the Sacramento Metropolitan Air Quality Management District is experiencing a significant workload increase from guideline changes in the Carl Moyer and Sacramento Emergency Clean Air Transportation (SECAT) incentive programs; and

WHEREAS, the Land Use and Mobile Source Division is receiving increased funding to implement the Carl Moyer and SECAT incentive programs; and

WHEREAS, the District must meet the State Implementation Plan requirements; and

WHEREAS, the increased long term workload resulting from the Carl Moyer guideline requirements and funding increases support the conversion of limited term positions to permanent status; and

WHEREAS, there are seven (7) limited perm positions approved in the budget but only five of these positions are proposed to become permanent;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED by the Board of Directors of the Sacramento Metropolitan Air Quality Management District to convert the four existing limited term Assistant/Associate Air Quality Specialists to permanent and convert one existing limited term Program Coordinator to permanent in the Land Use and Mobile Source Division; and

LET IT BE FURTHER RESOLVED by the Board of Directors of the Sacramento Metropolitan Air Quality Management District to eliminate from the budget the two limited term positions that are not converted to permanent.
