- 1 Join the meeting



- 2 Click the Interpretation icon



- 3 Choose your language

- 4 Mute original audio (optional)



Accessing an Interpreter

1. Join virtual meeting using either Zoom's desktop version or mobile app
2. Click the Interpretation Icon (*a globe*)
On Desktop: look at bottom of Zoom Window
On Mobile: Tap the screen to show controls, then tap "More"(...) Menu
3. Choose Your Language Channel
4. Mute Original Audio

Make sure you're using the Zoom app, *not a browser*

Make sure you're using the latest version of Zoom

4. Silencie el audio original

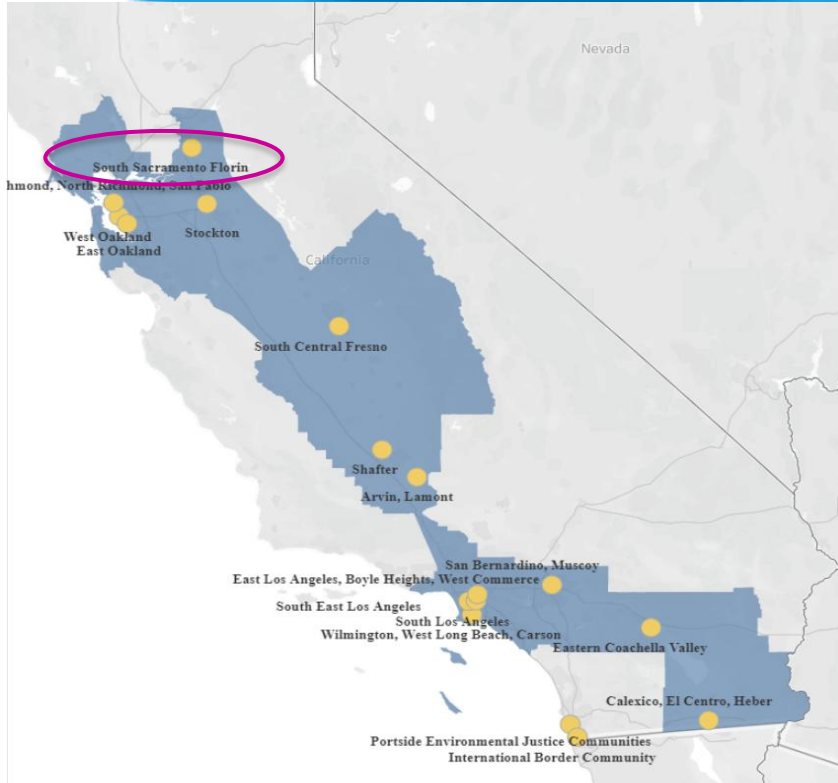

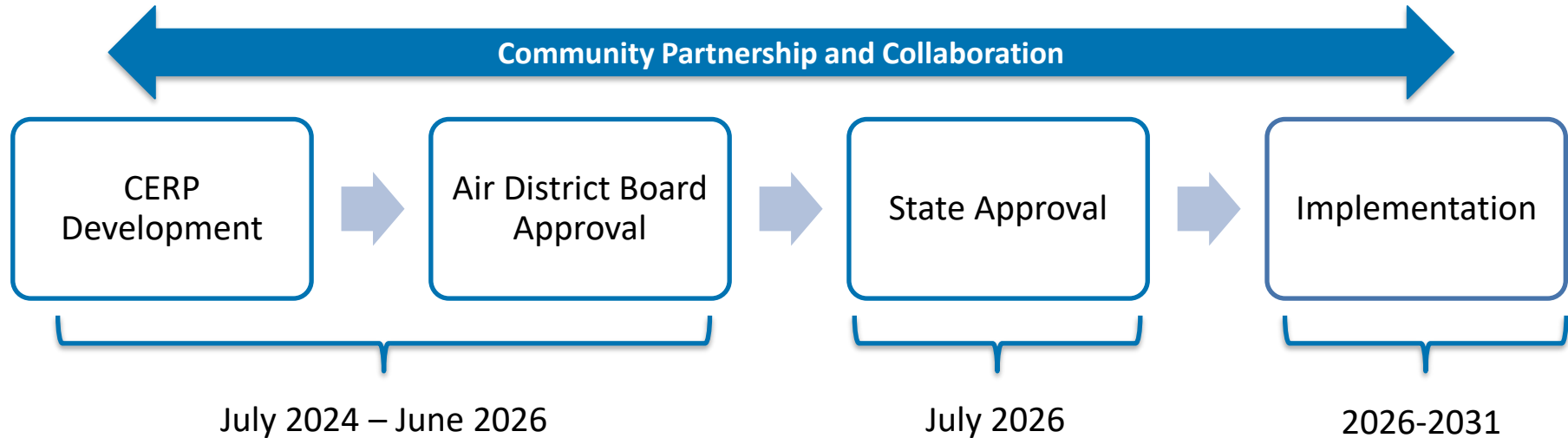
AB 617– Community Air Protection

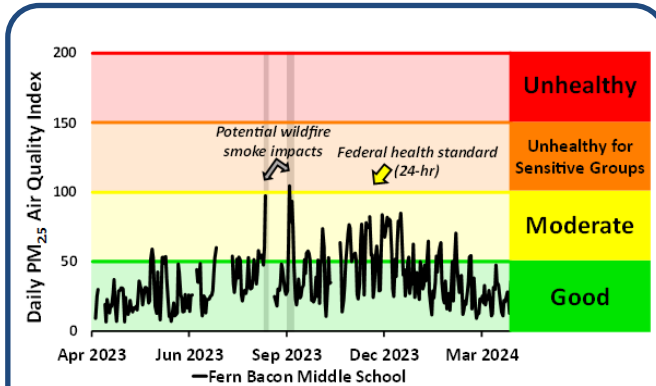

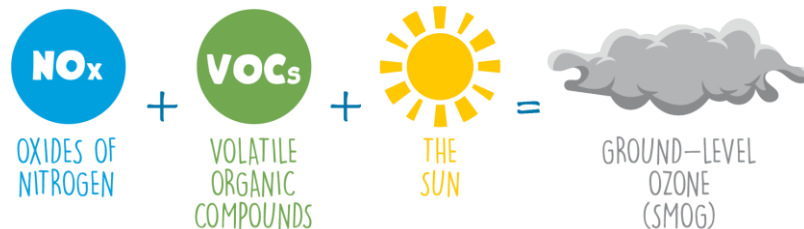

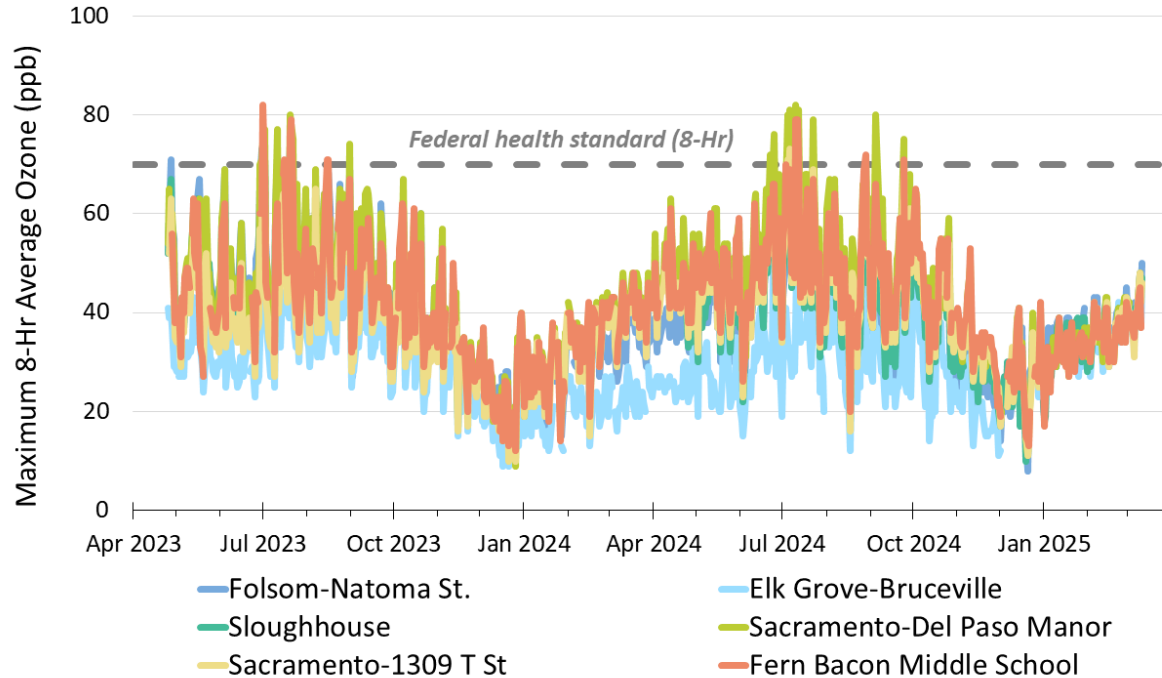
Sources of Nitrogen Oxides

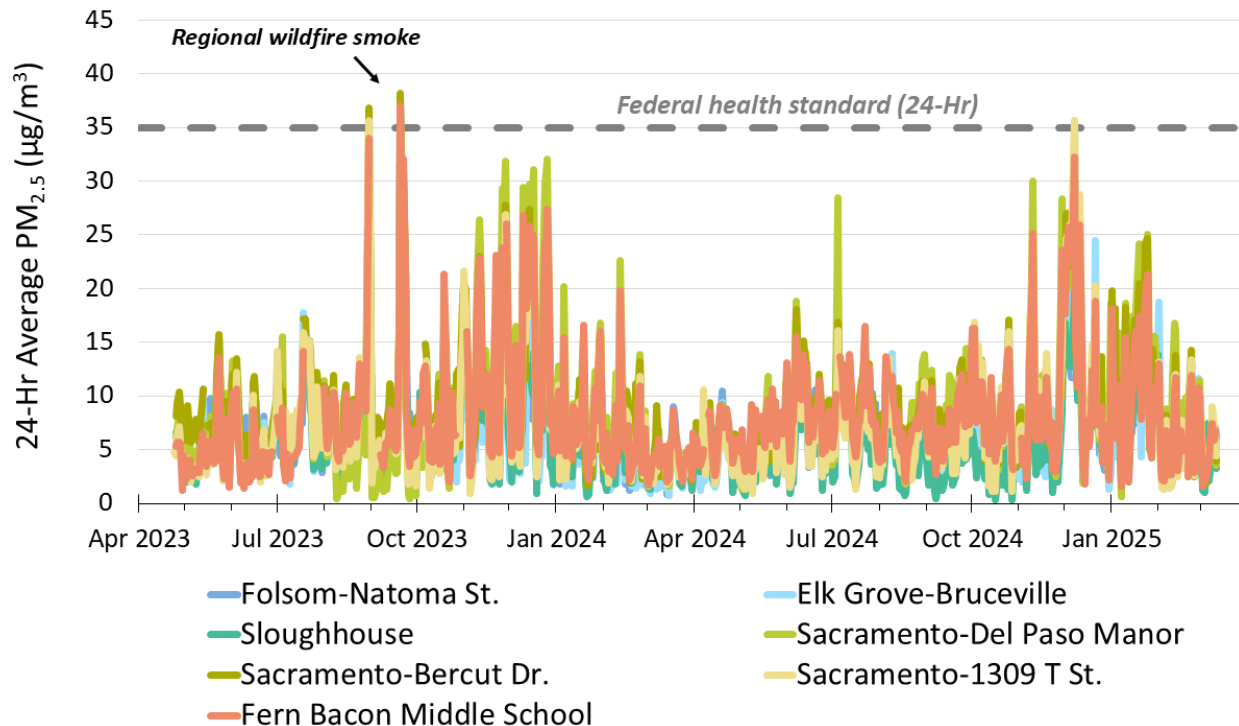
Particulate Matter



Diesel Particulate Matter



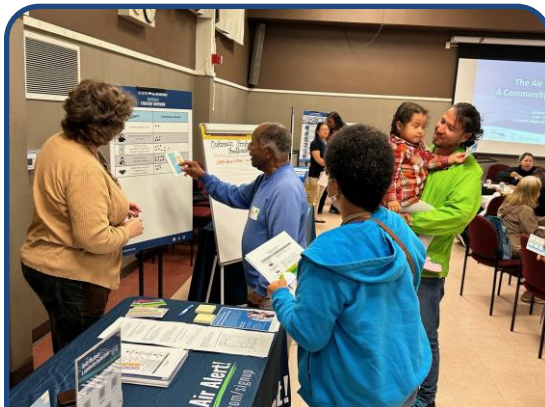

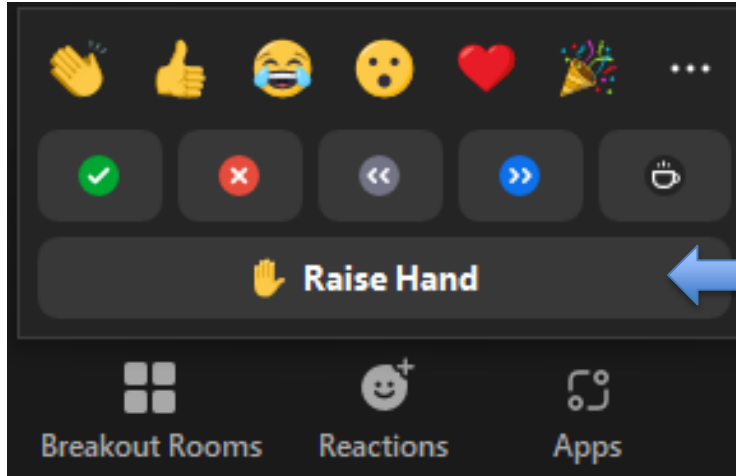
