2a. Outreach Subcommittee Updates

District Staff gave the following updates, listed below:

- 1. Status of purchasing outreach materials Shirts have been purchased and will be embroidered soon. Other approved outreach items will be purchased soon.
- 2. Recruitment Update District staff received approximately seven Steering Committee applications and are in the process of following up with applicants to finalize applications.
- 3. AB 617 Community Event Tentative date: October 15 It was noted that an AB 617 Community Event is being considered for October.

4a. Valley Vision Presentation

Valley Vision staff gave a presentation on their new Community Cycle 5 Air Grant. The purpose of the grant is to conduct outreach and engagement activities that increase the visibility, participation and impact of the South Sacramento-Florin AB 617 Community Steering Committee's outreach and engagement through March 2027.

5. CERP Team Report Out

The four subcommittees developed 28 strategies. The Urban Planning and Mobile Sources and Commercial Subcommittees presented the strategies they developed for the District to consider the feasibility of the proposed strategies.

- a. **Urban Planning and Mobile Sources** a co-lead presented the 11 strategies proposed. The following main comments were provided:
 - A community member suggested that feasibility for tree canopy strategy could include some sort of location.
 - A Steering Committee member requested that information be shared about the success of similar plans (Clean Mobility options with Zero Emissions Vehicles and Infrastructure) with the rest of the Steering Committee.
 - A Steering Committee member suggested using a different word for fueling to clarify if hydrogen, ZEV, or both (Commercial vehicle replacement program)
 - A Steering Committee member suggested we strengthen and clarify the language to be more specific about the actionable steps (Safe and Resilient Streets).
- b. **Commercial Sources** a Steering Committee member introduced the 6 strategies proposed to be considered for feasibility. The following main comments were provided:
- A community member clarified that BERC needs to be clarified in the strategies as a Sacramento County Agency
- Spell out acronyms in strategies for clarity
- New strategy idea was proposed to add other agencies information to our portal/website or vice versa
