

General Development Review process. This is the basic development process. Sacramento County is used as a specific example, but other jurisdictions follow the same general process.

- I. Zoning and Entitlements. What is the activity? PER
 - Nondiscretionary: no hearing.
 - Discretionary: hearing & notice.
 - Opportunities for comment & public involvement
- 2. Site Improvements. How will it be served? SIPS
 - Civil improvements
 - Grading plan
- 3. Building permits. How will it be constructed? BPI
 - Residential
 - Commercial

Sacramento County - Upcoming Long Range Planning Efforts

Stockton Boulevard Special Planning Area (SPA) – PER

Stockton Boulevard Complete Streets – SacDOT

- Installation of a Class IV protected bikeway between Florin Rd. and Elsie Ave.
- Two alternatives: one-way bike lanes or a two-way bike path
