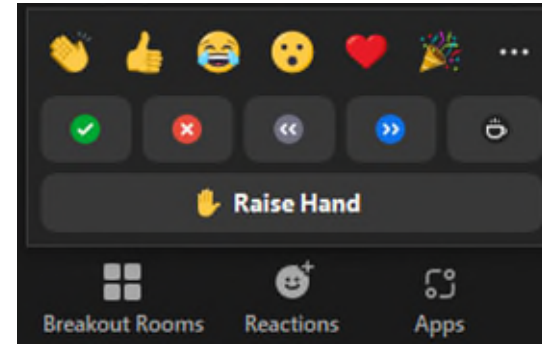

# CERP Vote

## What is a Community Emission Reduction Program or CERP?

- An action plan and program developed for the community to reduce emissions or exposure

## What does this vote mean?

- Starts the process of becoming recognized by the State as a CERP community
- Commitment to adopt a CERP within the two-year time frame (Clock starts July, deadline June 2026)

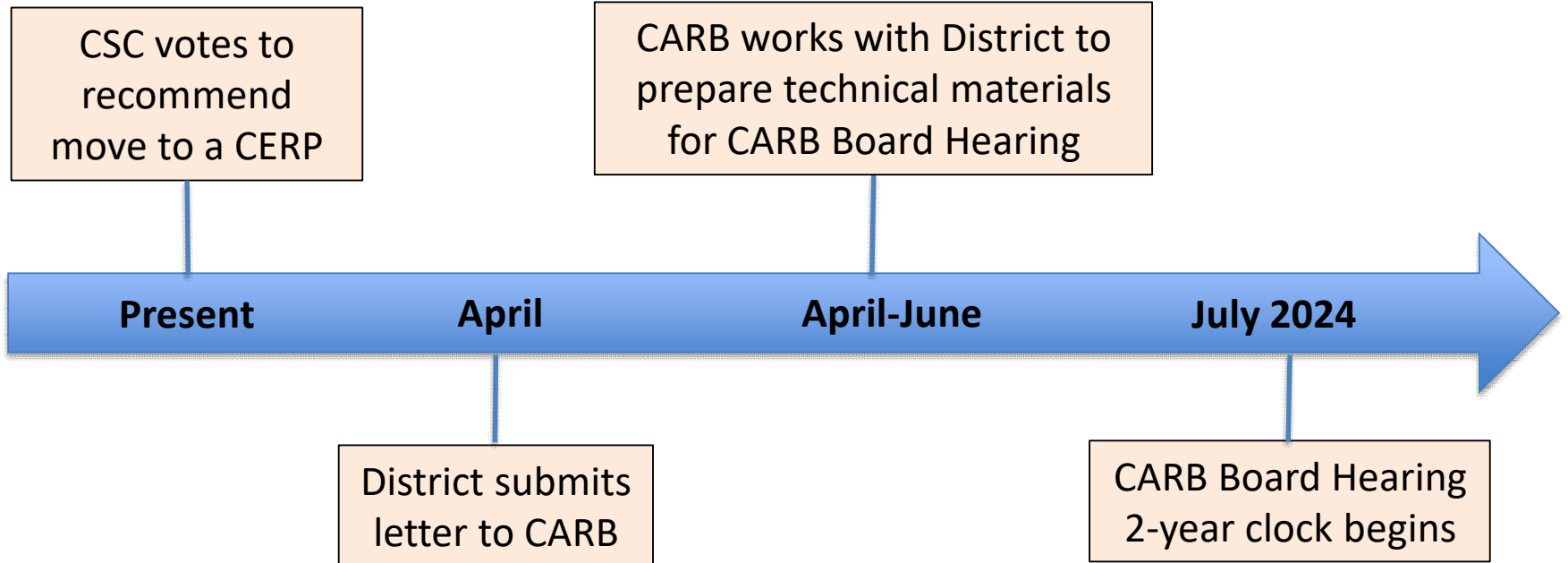
## Benefits

- Focused efforts on developing local emission and exposure reduction strategies to meet a community-defined goal
- Lessons learned and strategies from other CERP communities
- CARB incentive guidelines are more flexible for CERP communities
- Funding secured

## Considerations

- Increased time demand/workload for CSC Members; must stay on schedule to meet the deadline
- Potential increase meeting frequency
- Follow CERP elements in Blueprint 2.0

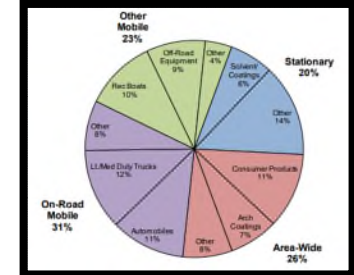
