AIR POLLUTION & HEALTH

The two most common air pollutants are ground-level ozone and particulates. Air pollution occurs when harmful gases, dust, or smoke enter the atmosphere. They harm people, animals, and the planet. Air pollution can increase the risk of serious health problems.
