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2019 School Bus Solicitation

- Incentives Available - \$5 Million
 - Open from October 15 to December 20, 2019
 - TIER 1 - One (1) Free* Electric Bus
Sacramento County School Districts
*Funding limits apply per bus; match HVIP funding
 - TIER 2 - \$70,000 or less* per Electric Bus Purchase
Priority based on AB617 and DAC
Final purchase cost depends on school's purchase order
 - TIER 3 - Up to \$60,000/grant for Ultra-Low NOx school bus



2019 School Bus Solicitation: Tier I

- TIER I - One (1) Free Electric Bus
 - Sacramento County School Districts are eligible
 - Funding available up to \$230,000 per bus after HVIP
(estimated up to \$465,000 combined funding)
 - Funding amount must meet cost-effectiveness
(\$/ton calculations based on bus or fleet usage)
 - Replacement Project – old bus is salvaged

2019 School Bus Solicitation: Tier 2

- TIER 2 - \$70,000 or less per Electric Bus Purchase
 - Sacramento County School Districts are eligible
 - Funding available at up to \$180,000 per bus after HVIP
(estimated up to \$415,000 combined funding)
 - Funding amount must meet cost-effectiveness
(\$/ton calculations based on bus usage)
 - Replacement Project – old bus is salvaged

2019 School Bus Solicitation: Tier 3

- TIER 3 - Up to \$60,000/grant for Ultra-Low NO_x school bus – Limit 2 awards per district
 - Sacramento County School Districts are eligible
 - Bus fleet count must be 10% electric in-use, route buses
 - Fleet must be compliant with CARB Truck and Bus Regulation prior to award
 - Replacement Project – old bus is salvaged
