MEETING MINUTES
October 15, 2025

1. Call to Order / Roll Call / Introductions

A regular meeting of the Sacramento Valley Basinwide Air Pollution Control Council, Technical Advisory Committee was called to order by Chair Joseph Tona at 1:32 pm via Zoom teleconference. Attendees were as follows:

2. Period of Public Comment

Mr. Tona opened the floor to public comment; hearing none, the public comment period was closed.

3. Approval of Minutes from the September 17, 2025 Meeting

MOTION: Mr. White moved to approve the minutes as presented. The motion was seconded by Ms. Roberts, and the motion passed with no objections and one abstention.

4. Approval of Financial Status Report as of September 30, 2025

Ms. LaGrone submitted financial reports through September 30, 2025 and warrants to be paid.

MOTION: Mr. Ertle moved to approve the financial reports as presented. The motion was seconded by Ms. Bennitt, and the motion passed with no abstentions or objections.

5. Status Reports

- CAPCOA – Mr. Tona reported that Jack Broadbent and Chair Lauren Sanchez are scheduled to speak at the CAPCOA 50th anniversary party.
- PEEPs – no report.
- CA Air Resources Board (CARB) – no report.
- SMP Committee – no report.
- SMP Coordinator – Coordinator Tawa provided a mid-season report for the Fall Intensive Rice Burn Season. Highlights included 12,700 acres of rice burned thus far, and total acreage burned topping 17,000 acres. The season has gone well, with only one complaint, which was unrelated to rice burning.

6. BCC Fee Structure Discussion – Joe Tona

Mr. Tona said that the committee (Joe Tona, Erik White, Amy Roberts, and Anastacia Allen) will meet November 7th. There was a short discussion and general feeling that lawyers should help to interpret the language of the Health and Safety Code that governs the BCC's fee structure. Mr. White added that changes may need to be made to the bylaws regarding the fee structure.

7. BCC Legislative Platform – Gretchen Bennett

Ms. Bennett reviewed the current draft. There was discussion about letters of support or opposition being submitted with no less than unanimous support. Ms. Bennett will present the final version at the November TAC meeting for a vote.

8. Biomass Utilization

- a. SB 88 Report – Ms. Roberts reported Governor Newsom vetoed the bill, which had enjoyed bipartisan support. There are no plans to revisit this legislation next year.
- b. Other biomass member news: no report.

My apologies as I intended to follow up sooner, but I wanted to make sure our team had adequate time to discuss this further. It looks like there was a previous temporary dues reduction that expired. However, after talking with CSDA's leadership, we acknowledge that a large unforeseen year-over-year adjustment can result in budgetary challenges and wanted to propose a more incremental, 5-year timeline to implement those changes, with the 2026 dues being reduced to \$750.

I've attached a revised invoice reflecting that reduction, and I would be happy to continue the conversation if the agency is still facing hardship caused by membership dues in the 2026 year. Please let me know if there is any additional information or clarification that would be helpful.
