Subject: Agricultural Burn Permit Update – Weekend/Holiday Burning

Date: March 2022

Agricultural Burn Permit Condition Change – Advanced Notice Required for Weekend and Holiday Burning

In an effort to maintain agricultural burn permit fees at current levels, the Sac Metro Air District is streamlining program work and reducing operational costs by minimizing staffing on weekends. Therefore, weekend burning will only be allowed when requested in advance.

Effective immediately, the District is updating all Agricultural Burn Permits to reflect the advanced notice requirement. The following language has been added to permit condition #4:

*Burning will not be authorized on weekends and holidays unless approved in advance.
Requests to burn on weekends and holidays must be submitted to the District at least
two business days in advance.*
